Barbute Helmet - venetian sallet



A barbute is a visorless war helmet of 15th-century Italian design, often with a distinctive T-shaped or Y-shaped opening for the eyes and mouth. The barbute is also called "barbuto", which in Italian literally means "bearded", possibly because the beard of a wearer would be visible.
